Directions:

Take the Sawgrass Expressway north to the end,
then turn left onto Powerline Road, 1/4 mile on left is
Quiet Waters Park. Take I-95 north to 10th St exit, go
west to Powerline Road, turn right, 1/4 mile past 10th
Street to the park.

Take turnpike to Sample Road, go east to Powerline
Road, then turn left, about 3 miles on left is the park.

For Those Coming From The North:

From the Turnpike southbound - Exit at Glades
Road, turn left and go east to Powerline/Jog Road,
turn right and go south about 3 miles. The park will
be on your right, just past Hillsboro Blvd. **From I-
95 southbound** - Exit at Hillsboro Blvd. go west to
Powerline Road, turn left and go south. The park will
be on your right, just past Hillsboro Blvd.
